ATTIRE AND EQUIPMENT

Uniform

- Day 1-4: Agency classroom Training Uniform
- Day 5-6: Agency rough duty training uniform and duty gear. Equipment required: bump helmet, safety glasses, gloves, knee pads, hydration system and head lamp with red or blue lens capabilities.

Schedule:

*Day 1-4 of the course is held at the STC Campus in Pharr, TX. On day 4 we will be moving to a secure training site in Brooks County and will be staying on site until day 6 in the evening. The course provides 63 hours of CE credit. Details to follow once candidates are registered.

* The practical scenarios in this course are designed to be as realistic as possible. Be prepared for training indoors and outdoors regardless of weather conditions outdoors. Clothing and other equipment may become soiled or damaged during this training.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Participating students must hold a current certification of EMT or higher.
